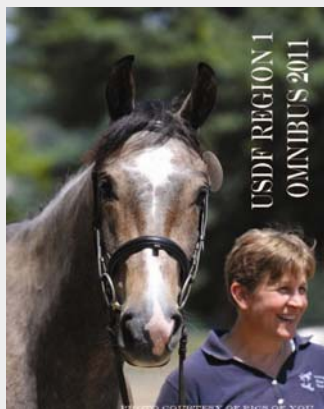

Check www.cblm.org to verify the scores you need to qualify and the current rules. New this year is an on-line qualification form which will make submitting your scores much easier. Qualification opportunities are numerous, starting with March Magic Dressage in Williamston, NC. There are shows offering qualifying classes from Connecticut to North Carolina. Check the BLM website calendar to determine which shows are qualifier shows. Additionally, there are numerous participating GMOs located from Connecticut to North Carolina.
